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01 A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY




02 DESIGN DRIVERS AND BENCHMARKS








03 A PLACEMAKING STRATEGY

In order to shape the way the community experiences Kershaw Gardens the following placemaking themes have been developed to ensure a meaningful environment is created and supports the design intent of delivering a 'big backyard' for all people. These placemaking themes have informed all elements of the design approach to create unified and responsive outcomes for the community of Rockhampton.



A CANVAS OF CONNECTED AND INCLUSIVE SPACES

Sculptured spaces are intuitively connected to create a welcoming invitation for people to come and enjoy everything Kershaw Gardens has to offer. Through its revitalisation it will deliver a destination parkland where you can enjoy the natural environment in a family friendly setting. In all corners it will offer high performing spaces connected by a network of active recreation pathways for the community to use and explore everyday.





AN INTERACTIVE AND FLEXIBLE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

As Kershaw Gardens undergoes transformation, it is essential that new and existing environs are enhanced by providing a multi-function overlay that allow users flexibility to adapt and change functions on a daily basis. This will allow a full spectrum of uses to be integrated into the gardens to maximise latent potential and truly knit the landscape into the fabric of the community.









A sense of stewardship and belonging will be enhanced through an interlaced web of functional open spaces, outdoor rooms and playgrounds that create and encourage interaction within the community.

gatherings.
























ARTIST IMPRESSION - SHADED OPEN SPACE, MOUNDING AND ROCKBED



NORTH PRECINCT

KEY ELEMENTS

- 1 THE RESERVE Northern entry gateway in a natural setting
- 2 THE WATERFALL An engaging waters edge that provides various photo opportunity
- 3 THE ROCK BED A rock creek bed that provides opportunity to sit by and relax
- 4 THE COMMUNITY LAWN An open space at scale appropriate for community events
- 5 THE WETLANDS A low lying ephemeral waterbody that creates new habitat for fauna









CENTRAL PRECINCT

- MAZE A landscaped maze incorporated into the existing garden








SOUTH PRECINCT

- 1 DOG PARK A small open space with agility elements for dogs








07 STRATEGIES FOR CHARACTER AND DETAILS

The cohesion, integration and interplay of the following landscape components represent the fine grain richness of the landscape that will contribute to the overarching desired outcomes. In a pragmatic sense, the design of individual components is intended to primarily offer amenity to users and instil a sense of uniqueness and quality into the landscape that draw inspiration from the natural and cultural environment.

MATERIALITY

The hardscape of Kershaw Gardens will create a truly natural setting that is defined by earthy tones and rich textures. The design and application of the material palette will be manageable from a maintenance perspective with clean detailing that creates a sense of simplicity within the landscape.





PATHS


The hierarchy of the path network is defined by the materiality and dimension of the pathways. Primary paths will comfortably support high volume usage and service vehicles. Secondary paths allow for usage by cyclist and pedestrians whilst minor paths provide connections primarily for pedestrians.











FURNITURE AND ELEMENTS

A comprehensive and unifying landscape furniture suite will provide a distinctive character for Kershaw Gardens. Seating, signage, bins and lighting create a sense of cohesion in the landscape that amplify the sites natural setting through form and materiality.





LANDSCAPE PAVILIONS

An architectural suite of landscape pavilions will deliver visually exciting shade structures providing comfort and shelter.
The three variations provide a hierarchy in their usage including;


- the entertainment pavilion that accommodates dining and lounging with the greatest capacity,
- the dining pavilion which accommodates smaller gatherings and dining, and
- the garden pavilion which is focused around retreat and relaxation.











PLANTING

The planting will boast a display of flowering shrubs and trees that deliver a seasonal colour display offering visitors visual interest and delight. It will help create a richly coloured landscape that reinforces the vibrancy of our natural flora. A unique combination and variety of colours, enhanced by the deep tones of figs and subtle greys of eucalypts will be used in manner that creates zones of different colour. From vibrant yellows and oranges to the elegance of pinks and purples and pops of red, the planting throughout the precinct will be dramatic, engaging and a true spectacle of endemic species.



WETLANDS

Kershaw Gardens provides an opportunity to demonstrate environmental processes and habitat creation in a manner that is educational for the community. The primary focus of the wetlands is to preserve and enhance natural systems through environmental linkages that will encourage fauna activity.

The wetlands will provide an additional recreational destination within the gardens that will be a perfect spot for casual retreat and bird watching.



CREEK

A major component of Kershaw Gardens that is underutilised as a key amenity driver is Moores Creek. The revitalisation of Moores Creek in conjunction with the wetlands creates an excellent opportunity to create a water system that has recreational and ecological roles. The provision for a series of board walks, landscape pavilions for respite and edges that encourage interaction will provide infinite possibilities for community usage and engagement with the natural system.




NATURE PLAY

The nature play will be interactive and reimage natural materials and elements for all ages to use. The space will be supportive of natural surveillance and provide parents with a comfortable environment to sit and observe.



PASSIVE WATER PLAY

The waterplay component of Kershaw Gardens will be a hive of activity. Based on a natural environment the space will be highly shaded for user comfort and safety.



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
