BULK WASTE ITEMS THAT CAN AND CAN'T BE COLLECTED

Rockhampton Regional Council has engaged local contractors to collect bulk waste from kerbside to assist with recovery after Cyclone Debbie. There are some items that cannot be collected as part of the bulk waste collection as it may be hazardous, needs special transport or special treatment. If you need further advice please call customer service 1300 22 55 77.

This flyer has been left in your letter box to remind you of the items that can be collected and those items indicated below that have been left on your footpath as they cannot be collected as part of the bulk waste collection.

✓ OK TO PLACE ON FOOTPATH ITEMS WILL BE COLLECTED	✗ DON'T PLACE ON FOOTPATH ITEMS WON'T BE COLLECTED	FOR MATERIALS THAT CANNOT BE COLLECTED
✓ Building materials including timber, metal, glass etc – not larger than 1.8 metres in length	✗ Car bodies, boats, tyres or engines	Dispose of through a specialist recycling company by looking in the Yellow Pages under 'Waste Reduction & Disposal' or take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
✓ Broken furniture	✗ Food items	Place in your wheelie bin for normal collection or take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
✓ White goods – not operating	✗ Soil, gravel, rubble	Take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
✓ Mattresses	✗ Dead animals	Take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
✓ Household items	✗ Fireworks, ammunition or explosives	Call the Explosives Inspectorate on 1300 739 868 . If unexploded ordnance is located, inform Police Emergency that a possible ammunition item has been found. They will instigate a request for Defence personnel to attend and dispose of the item. 	✗ Green waste	Take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
	✗ Building materials greater than 1.8 metres in length	Take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
	✗ Chemicals such as acids, chlorine, pesticides	Dispose of through a specialist disposal company by looking in the Yellow Pages under 'Waste Reduction & Disposal' or visit Chem Clear at www.chemclear.com.au
	✗ Any fluids such as hydrocarbons, oils, paints, cooking oils	Take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
	✗ Gas cylinders, oxyacetylene cylinders	Take to the Lakes Creek Road waste management facility*
	✗ Medical waste including pharmaceutical products, needles or sharps	Dispose of through a specialist disposal company by looking in the Yellow Pages under 'Waste Reduction & Disposal' or visit Chem Clear at www.chemclear.com.au
	✗ Asbestos Containing Material (ACM)	If you have suspected asbestos please contact your insurance company or the Customer Service Centre on 1300 22 5577
