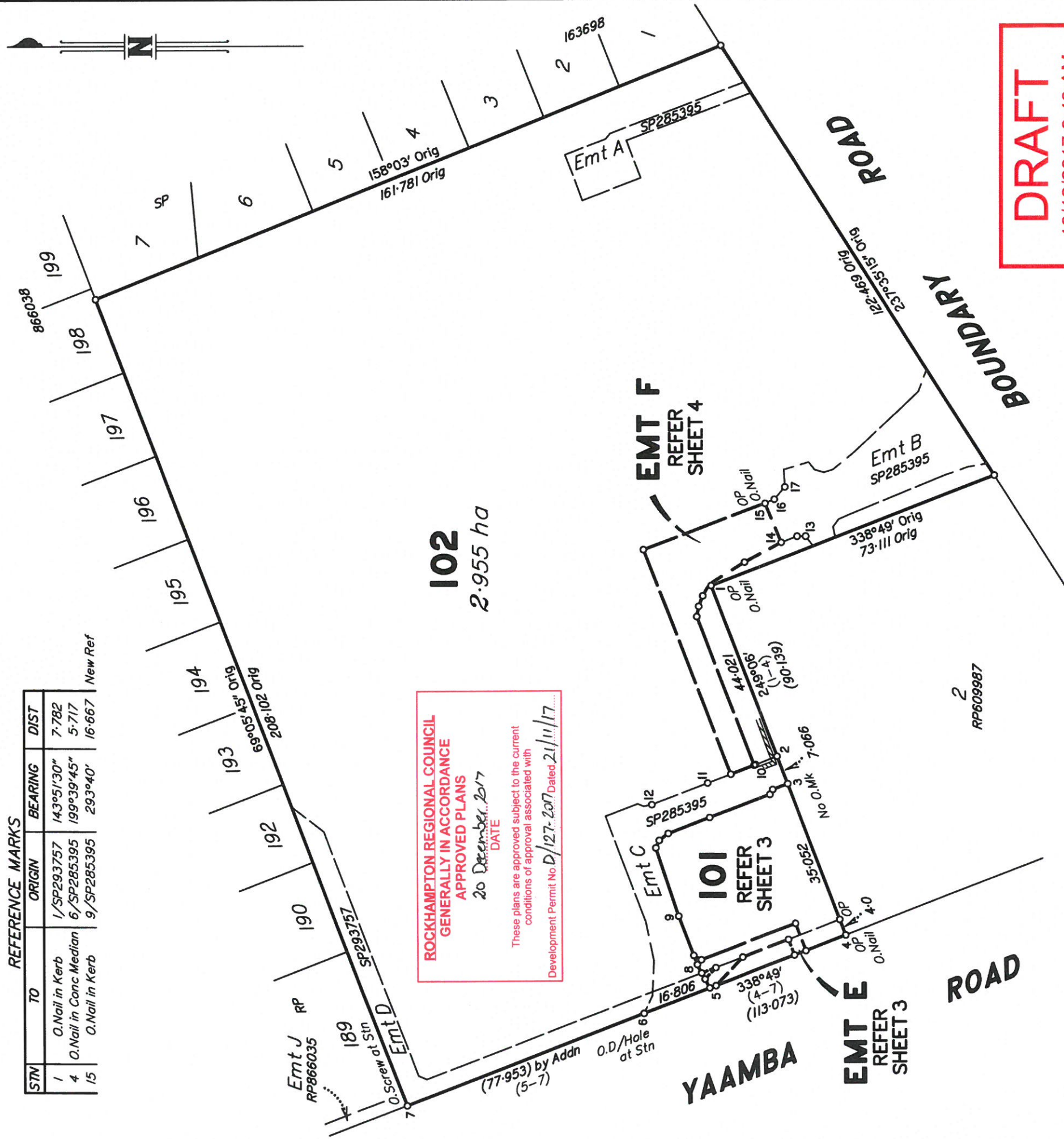

Reinstatement Report:

Plans Searched: SP293757, SP285395 and SP224442

All original stations fixed by original monuments and/or recovery marks, and dimensions agree with the previous surveys, with the exception of station 15, where the corner was fixed by O.Drill hole in back of kerb. An excess of 0.090m was measured and shown between stations 14 and 15, and an excess of 0.006 measured and shown between stations 15 and 16, when compared with the previous survey SP285395.

Drill Hole in Kerb placed at all new Stations unless noted otherwise.
