#### **GARDEN CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS**

#### **BEST USE OF NATIVE PLANTS**

Entries must consist of a significant proportion of Australian native plants presented in a layout that both enhances and compliments other plant varieties in the surrounding garden. The types of native plants used should possess ecological qualities such as attracting birds and butterflies.

#### **BEST FOOD GARDEN**

Entries may be vegetable gardens, fruit gardens, culinary herb gardens bush tucker gardens or gardens that are a combination of all of these.

Gardens entered must contain (consumable) produce, and may be the traditional bed type of garden, a container garden, a patio garden or a hydroponic garden.

#### **BEST YOUNG GARDENER/S**

Entries are open to all young gardening enthusiasts up to the age of 16, either as individuals or as groups. This category is for private gardens only and not to be incorporated into a business or school.

#### **BEST SCHOOL GARDEN**

Entries are open to all young green enthusiasts up to the age of 16, either as individuals or as groups, who have a home gardening or school gardening project they are especially proud of. Entries in this category must predominately be the result of the work of the young gardener/s themselves.

#### **BEST CORPORATE GARDEN**

Entry in this category is open to businesses, government and other corporate entities, training and tertiary education institutions, school grounds and community support organisations. Gardens entered in this category will have been created to beautify and compliment the facade and/or surrounds/grounds of the particular premises concerned.

#### **BEST FLOWER GARDEN**

Entries in this category are invited for either planted gardens, garden beds or pot gardens that are focused on providing an abundance of eyecatching colour and fragrance stemming from vibrant displays of spring annuals and/or seasonal flowering shrubs.

#### **BEST SENIOR'S GARDEN**

This category is open to anyone over the ages of 60 who considers themselves to be a senior. Entrants can enter with a private residence or be residents of a garden they maintain in a retirement village or complex that they have established and personally maintain. This includes pot gardens.

#### **BEST ENVIRONMENTAL/SUSTAINABLE GARDEN**

This category is open to all gardens that show an overall provision of forward thinking towards the environment and sustainability. Judges will be looking for gardening practices that protect, restore and enhance the ability of landscapes/gardens to provide ecosystem services that benefit humans and other organisms. Recycled Repurposed Remade items will be a main feature of this category.
