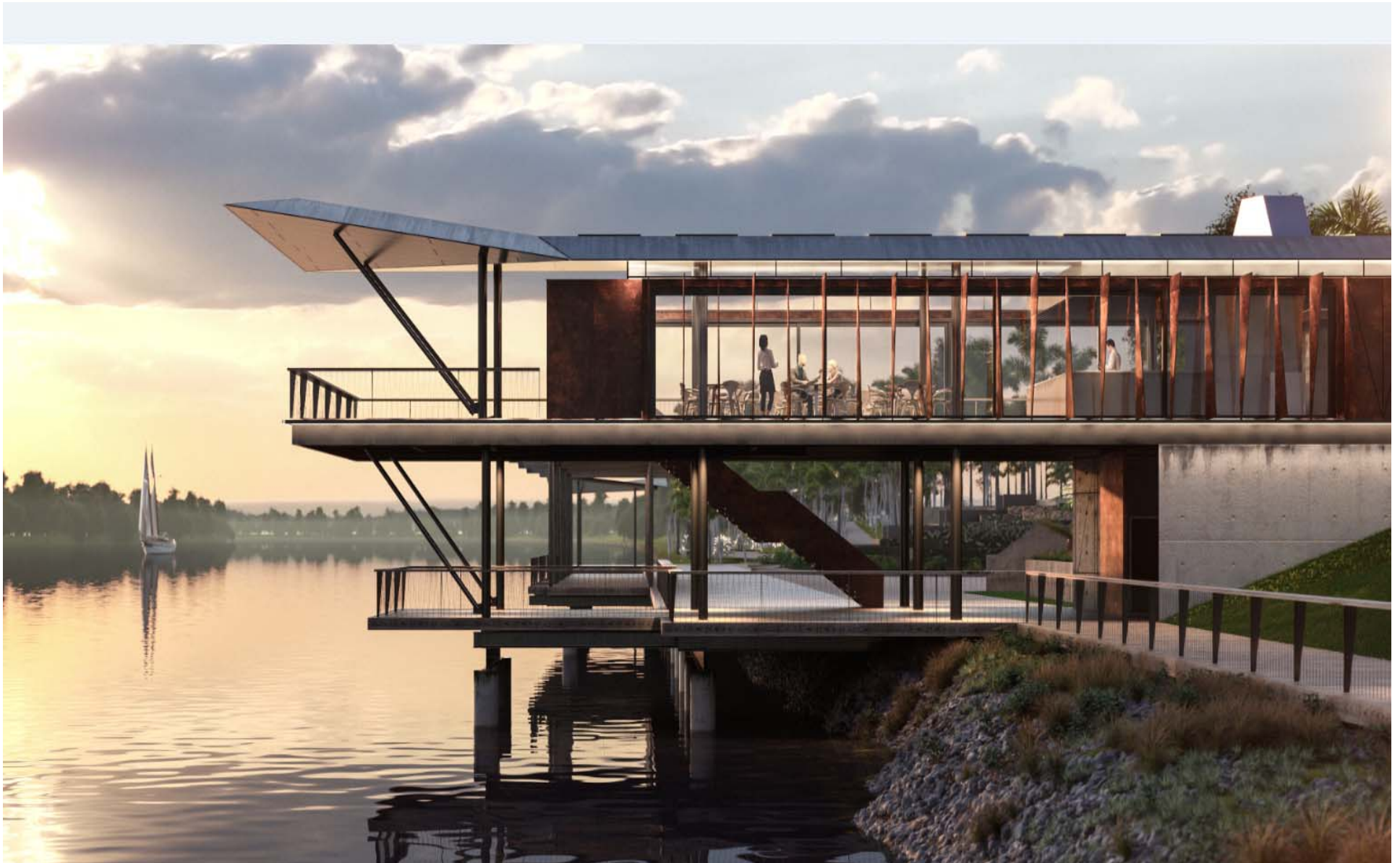


## Waste and Recycling Update

- Seven replacement waste collection vehicles being received Sept / Oct 2017.
- These vehicles will have special signs placed on them to promote recycling, waste minimisation and correct placement of the wheelie bin for collection.
- Mattress recycling – Council through Rockhampton Regional Waste and Recycling has commenced to recycle inner spring mattresses.
- About 40 a week are being processed at Lakes Creek Road Landfill.
- Other staffed sites have recently commenced this operation. The cloth / material part of the mattress is separated from the inner metal spring component.
- The cloth / material is disposed of at present via landfill, though an investigation is under way to see if this product can be recycled.

### Quay Street

- Works along Quay St between Fitzroy St and William St open to traffic (one way).
- Currently working on Denham St section between East St and Quay St.
- Expect all works to be completed by end of November (pending weather).

## Riverbank

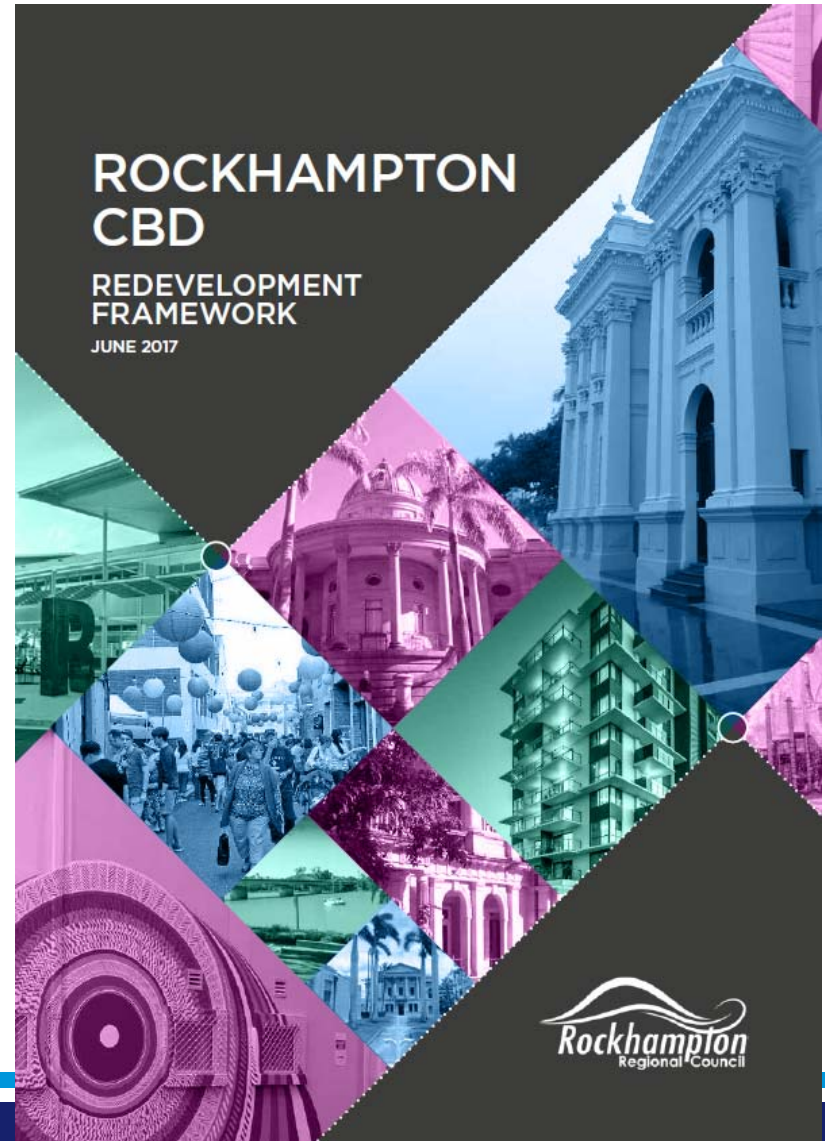
- Construction works are well underway and it is expected this will be open in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2018 (pending weather).
- The new Riverbank precinct will transform Rockhampton's iconic Quay Street into a recreational and cultural hub for businesses, locals and visitors.
- The Riverbank stage will have a dedicated restaurant/café, water play area, toilets, playground area and shaded areas.





# Rockhampton CBD Redevelopment Framework

- The vision for the Rockhampton CBD is to be the economic and cultural heart of the Region – a dynamic place that is thriving, sustainable, connected and memorable.
- It will have a strategic planning horizon of 10 to 15 years with catalyst projects to get the framework moving.

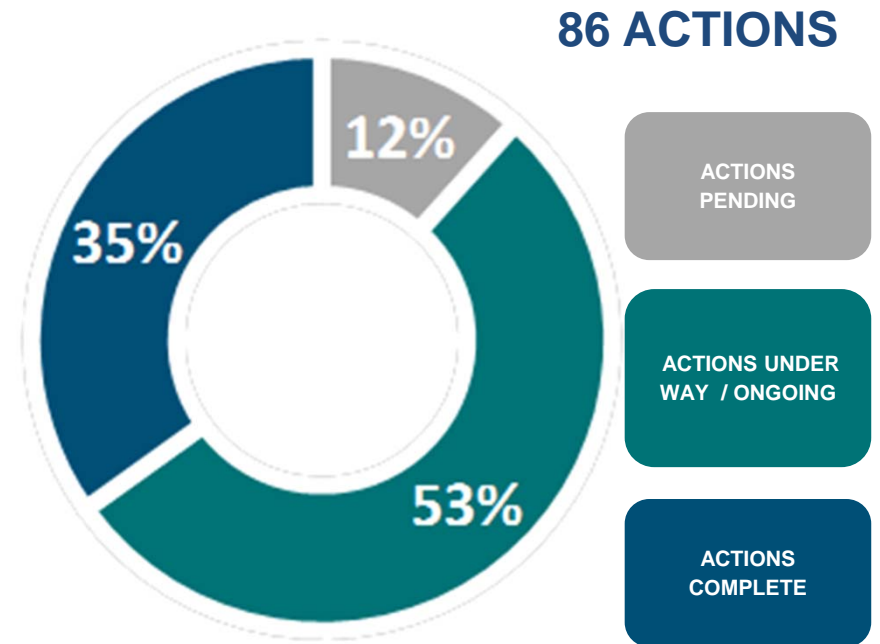

# In twelve months we've got some runs on the board...
