The following topics were covered:

- Flood levee and various questions. Information needs to be provided to real estate agents - some may be selling properties with incorrect information.
- Quay Street Precinct - Is it going to be two way? Access from Depot Hill to the Highway is difficult. Could the Quay Street area be changed to 40km/hour? General Manager Regional Services advised there is a report to come back to Council on this matter.
- Council is moving forward with developments in various areas, that's good. Why can't this be allocated to flood levee? Council is allocating \$15m, the flood levee is \$60m+.
- Fiddes Street - hooning issues and dragging up the road. A suggestion of speed bumps. Cr Wickerson is to have a chat with Hasting Deering about this matter.
- Railway site question. Response: Aurizon is investigating the opportunities.
- Supercars Rockhampton, what is happening here? Response: Our hope is a race in 2020.
- There was a suggestion that the Wintergarden site to be a car park initially. Then over a period of time, further developments.
- Giveaway signs, can we make them into the stop signs? Cr Wickerson to double check but engineers didn't think it was warranted due to standards.
- Long carparks for trailers. Can we assist these to get them to stay here longer on the southside?
- Markets at Gas Works Flats and condition of land surface.
- Corner of Murray and Wood Streets. Can we do a spoon drain? CSO to get details.
