

# FACT SHEET

## The Bard Awards 2022 Terms and Conditions

Each performer must agree to the below Terms and Conditions relating to The Bard Awards 2022:

- There are three categories: monologue, duologue and group scene.
- Each category is divided into two age groups – Junior (Year 7 – 9) and Senior (Year 10 – 12).
- All performers (including performers of duos) must register separately. Performers who are only applying for a Group Scene can apply through the Bard Awards 2022 Group Scenes Application Form, a separate individual form for each individual isn't required.
- Performance duration is to be a maximum of five minutes for monologues/duologues and 15 minutes for group scenes.
- Duologues/group scenes will be categorised into the age group of the oldest performer of the group.
- A performer may enter multiple times, but only once in each appropriate category.
- Repertoire selection is free choice – either a traditional or contemporary published work.
- A copy of each performer's script must be emailed to [majorvenues@rrc.qld.gov.au](mailto:majorvenues@rrc.qld.gov.au) no later than **5pm on Friday 30 September 2022**.
- Performances are to be recited by memory (without a script or prompts).
- Dress code is theatre blacks with enclosed shoes – **no costumes or school uniforms will be accepted**.
- Each performance is to be done on a plain stage, with basic white lighting (no music, sound effects or substantial props, performers may use a small hand prop).
- It is the performer's responsibility to ensure they are available for their performance time. Program times cannot be changed to suit individuals' availability. Please ensure you are available all day and early evening on **Sunday 9 October 2022** when submitting your application.
- A performance schedule will be emailed to all performers approximately one week before the event.
- The teacher/tutor is responsible for monitoring all performers in group scenes at all times while they are at The Pilbeam Theatre.
- The winners of each category will receive awards. Adjudication notes will be provided to each performer or group.
- The adjudicator's decision is final and not representative of the views of Rockhampton Regional Council.
- Applications close at **5pm on Friday 23 September 2022**.
- Free workshops will be available for all performers on Saturday 8 October 2022 (subject to change).
