





FIVE STEPS TO GET READY FOR A PANDEMIC

STEP ONE -UNDERSTAND YOUR RISK

What is a pandemic?

PANDEMICS are highly contagious viruses that are easily spread and can cause severe illness and loss of life.



COVID-19

Novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has affected people from many countries around the world. COVID-19 spreads between people, usually when a sick person coughs or sneezes. You might catch COVID-19 if someone with the virus sneezes or coughs onto you. You could also catch the virus if they have coughed or sneezed onto a surface (like a door handle) that you touch, getting the droplets on your hands and then transferring them to your mouth, nose or eyes when you touch your face or eat.

STEP TWO - MAKE A PLAN
