

PRIVATE GARDENS (Single Dwellings, Duplexes and Multi-Unit Developments)	No watering permitted during the hours of 9.00am to 4.00pm. Hand held watering on any day of the week between 4.00pm and 9.00am. Irrigation systems and sprinklers can only be used as follows: ● Odd numbered properties Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday; ● Even numbered properties Wednesday, Friday & Sunday; ● No watering permitted on Mondays. No restrictions for recycled water or bores.
CAR & BOAT WASHING	Hose fitted with a trigger or twist nozzle or bucket anytime
SWIMMING POOLS – EXISTING	No restrictions apply
SWIMMING POOLS – NEW	No restrictions apply
DRIVEWAYS/FOOTPATHS/HOUSES	Only with high pressure equipment
COMMERCIAL BUSINESSES	No restrictions apply for businesses that use potable water outside as part of their core business (eg: builders, dog washers, bricklayers, concrete cutters, pressure cleaners, landscapers, car and boat detailers)
BOWLING GREENS, GOLF GREENS ONLY, TURF CRICKET PITCHES	Restrictions as for private gardens Exemption required otherwise No restrictions for recycled water or bores
COMMERCIAL NURSERIES	No restrictions apply No restrictions for recycled water or bores
COUNCIL PARKS & GARDENS & SPORTS GROUNDS	Restrictions as for private gardens for potable water No restrictions for recycled water or bores
SCHOOLS	Restrictions as for private gardens Exemption required otherwise No restrictions for recycled water or bores
PUBLIC HEALTH PURPOSES	No restrictions apply
DEVELOPMENT SITES	No restrictions apply, however, use of non-potable water is preferred
STOCK WATERING	No restrictions apply
PUBLIC OUTDOOR SHOWERS	Public outdoor showers remain connected

COMMENCEMENT OF LEVEL 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS IN MOUNT MORGAN

Thank you for your assistance with reducing water usage since Level 1 Water Restrictions commenced on Monday 20 May 2019. This ongoing positive water-wise approach is very important in helping to conserve the water in No. 7 Dam. Unfortunately, with no significant recent rainfall, No. 7 Dam is now beneath 40% of full capacity and according to Council's Drought Management Plan, this storage level now triggers the implementation of Level 2 Water Restrictions and Council recently decided that it will do so accordingly.

Please be advised that **Level 2 Water Restrictions are to commence on Monday 9 September 2019** for all of the Mount Morgan and surrounding areas that are connected to the Mount Morgan Water Supply Scheme.


The purpose of implementing Level 2 Water Restrictions is to ensure that with warmer weather now arriving that all efforts continue to be made to use water wisely and ensure that the remaining supply in No. 7 Dam lasts as long as possible. Residents in Mount Morgan have proven that they are very good at conserving water and maximising the available water supply during extended periods and it is very important that this continues as summer approaches. Fitzroy River Water (FRW) looks forward to the community again doing its best for everyone who relies on the No. 7 Dam supply.

Please find on the other side of the page, a Fact Sheet of the measures that will take effect on 9 September 2019 for all water users as per the Drought Management Plan. The main change with Level 2 is the introduction of odds and evens watering days, and a handy reference card has been included also to show you which days you can use water around the house. Please note that irrigation of sporting fields and other grassed areas using recycled water from the Mount Morgan Sewage Treatment Plant will continue unrestricted. Should any residential or commercial customers wish to apply for an exemption from Level 2 Water Restrictions please contact FRW accordingly.

FRW will continue monitoring the No. 7 Dam storage level and water consumption over the coming months and will provide further updates as required. We appreciate your understanding of the importance of the implementation of Level 2 water restrictions as we move into the drier months of the year.
