

Bin liners

There is no requirement to use caddy or bin liners. Actually, there are several effective alternatives to manufactured liners. These include wrapping food waste in:

- Newspaper
- Paper towel
- Brown paper

You can also place a layer of cardboard or dry leaves on the bottom of your caddy.

Bags that say “biodegradable”, “degradable” or “plant based” are strictly not suitable as they still either contain or are entirely made from plastic, and we most definitely do not want to be contaminating compost with plastic as it will leach toxins into our soil, waterways and food crops.

Important: if you choose to purchase your own compostable bags (available in supermarkets and hardware stores), please purchase bags with the symbols as shown on the right.
