Attachment 2—Reasons for referral agency response

The reasons for SARA's decision are:

- The proposal is for a development permit for the reconfiguration of a lot from 1 lot into 4 lots at 5 Mclaughlin Street, Parkhurst formally described as Lot 5 on SP333392.
- The proposed development has triggered referral for exceedance of Industry Activity under Schedule 20 of the Planning regulation 2017.
- SARA assessed the development application against State code 6: Protection of state transport networks of the SDAP, version 3.0 and determined that without conditions, the development achieves compliance with the performance outcomes of the State code.
