5. INFRASTRUCTURE CHARGE

The contribution required to be paid is \$587,953.50.

This charge is subject to automatic increases from when the charges are levied until when they are paid in accordance with section 114 of the *Planning Act 2016* and Council's *Adopted Infrastructure Charges Resolution (No.5) 2015*.

The infrastructure charges have been calculated as follows:

- (a) A charge of \$560,014.00 for Gross Floor Area being 4,706 square metres;
- (b) A charge of \$27,939.50 for Impervious Area being 3,287.00 square metres (roof area, hardstand areas, access, and parking areas); and
- (c) No Infrastructure Credit being applicable.

Therefore a total charge of \$589,953.50 is payable for the development.

No offsets or refunds are applicable for the development.

6. WHEN CHARGE IS PAYABLE

The infrastructure charges of \$587,953.50 must be paid when the change of use happens.
