PART 1—INTRODUCTION

Division 1 — Relationship with the Integrated Planning Act 1997

1 Purpose of planning scheme

- (1) This planning scheme for the Shire of Mount Morgan is the framework for managing development in a way that advances the purpose of the *Integrated Planning Act* 1997¹ by –
 - (a) Identifying assessable and self-assessable development; and
 - (b) Identifying outcomes to be achieved in the context of assessing development.

2 Planning scheme functions as part of IDAS

(2) The planning scheme is to be read in conjunction with the Integrated Planning Act 1997² and functions as part of IDAS.³

⁽a) coordinating and integrating planning at the local, regional and State levels; and

⁽b) managing the process by which development occurs; and

⁽c) managing the effects of development on the environment (including the managing the use of premises).
