Division 1 — Preliminary

12 Desired environmental outcomes

- (1) The desired environmental outcomes are the basis upon which the planning scheme has been constructed.
- (2) Each *desired environmental outcome* applies to the whole of the shire and is sought to be achieved to the extent practical, having regard to each other *desired environmental outcome*.
- (2) The *desired environmental outcomes* relate to four key areas. The four key areas are-
 - (a) **Quality of Life**
 - (b) **Economic Development**
 - (c) **Heritage and Town Character**
 - (d) **Rural and Natural Areas**
