12 Desired environmental outcomes

- (1) The desired environmental outcomes are the basis upon which the planning scheme has been constructed.
- (2) Each desired environmental outcome applies to the whole of the shire and is sought to be achieved to the extent practical, having regard to each other desired environmental outcome.
- (2) The desired environmental outcomes relate to four key areas. The four key areas are-
 - (a) Quality of Life
 - (b) Economic Development
 - (c) Heritage and Town Character
 - (d) Rural and Natural Areas
