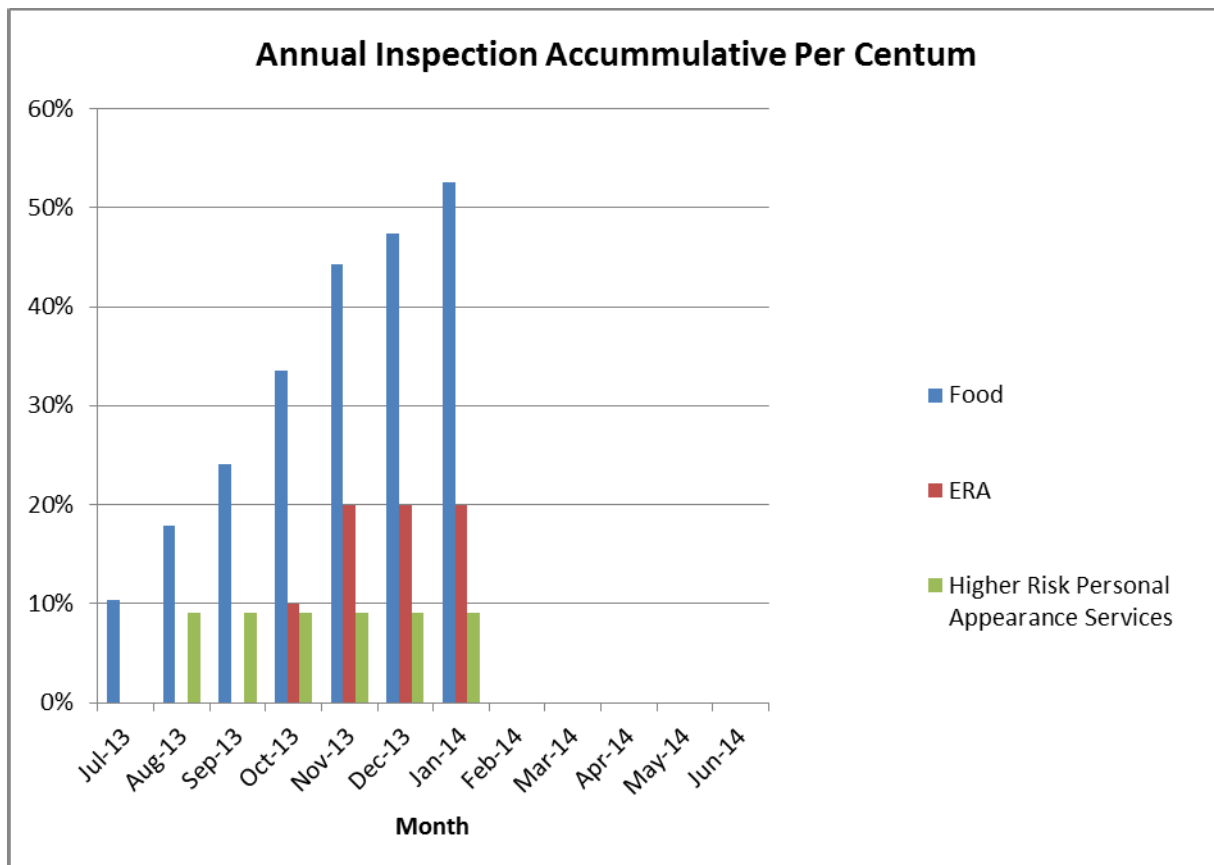
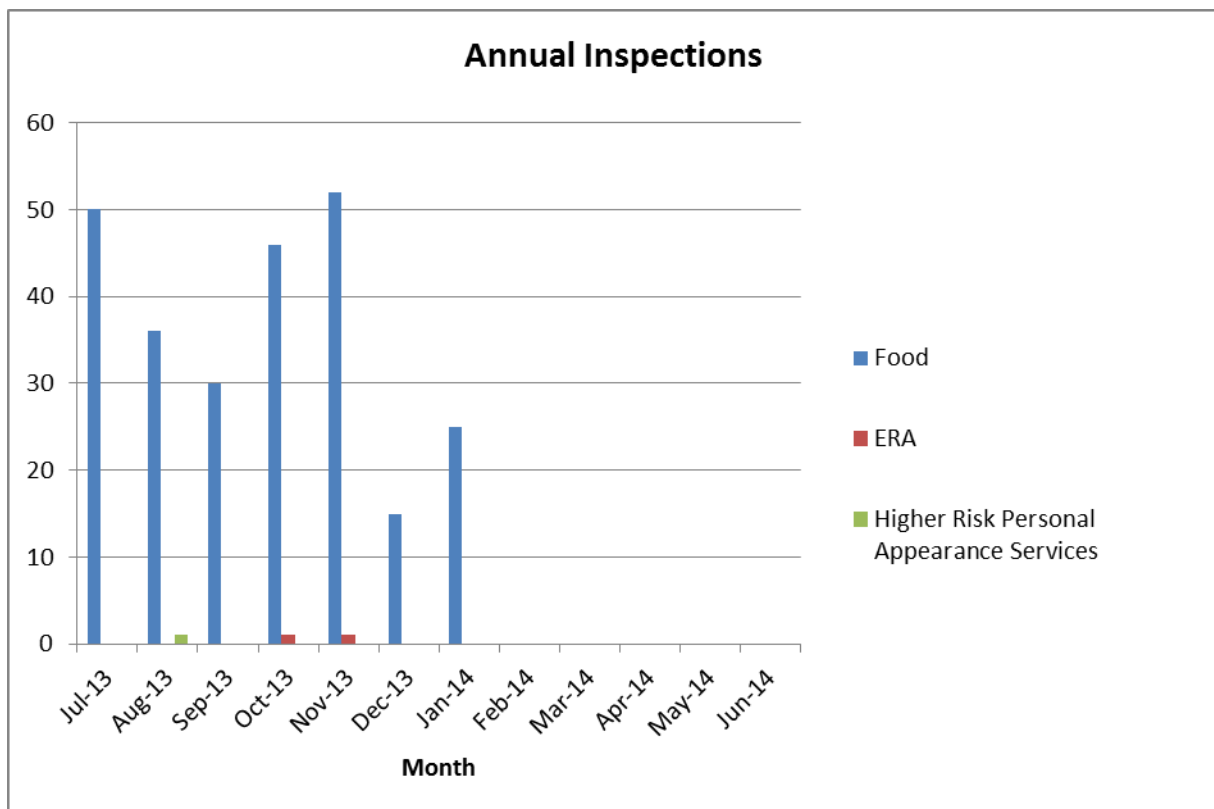

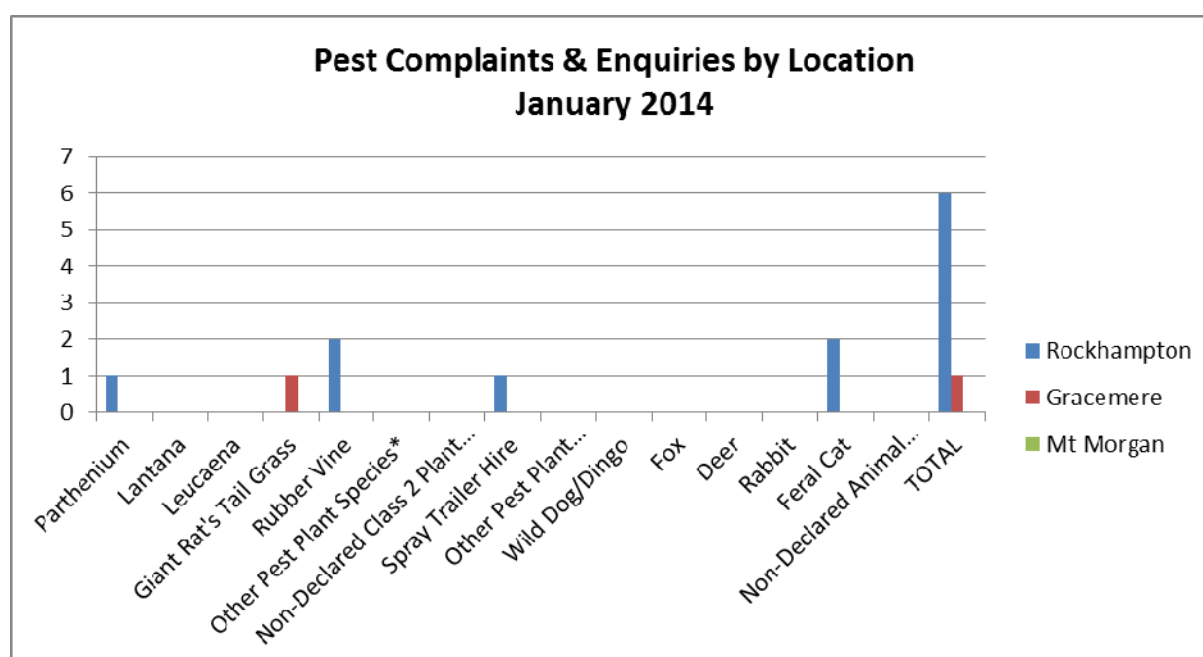

VECTOR MANAGEMENT

The following is a summary of the activities of the Pest Management Unit for the month of January 2014.

Surveillance of Fitzroy River: Scheduled surveillance was undertaken on two occasions with a total of seventeen sites sampled. Mosquito breeding above the threshold was found on sixteen sites initiating treatment of these sites with a total of 303 hectares being treated. Post surveillance was unable to be undertaken due to the inclement weather conditions cutting access to the sites. As a result calculation of the efficacy of the treatment was not possible.

Surveillance of Urban Saltmarsh: Scheduled surveillance was undertaken on one site. Above-threshold mosquito breeding was found in this site, which was treated. Post-treatment sampling indicated a 100 per centum larva mortality rate.

Surveillance of Freshwater Areas: Surveillance of thirty-nine freshwater sites was undertaken. Above-threshold mosquito breeding was found in two sites, which were treated. Post-treatment sampling indicated a 100 per centum larva mortality rate.

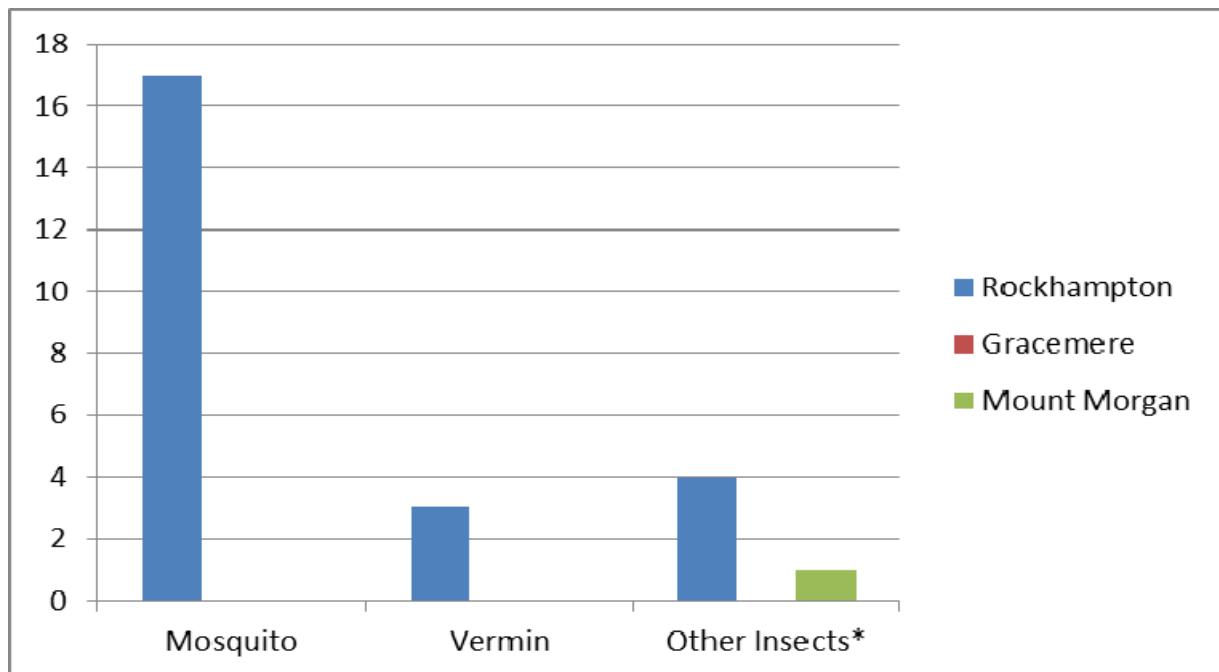

Animal Infringements Comparison Year to Date January 2014

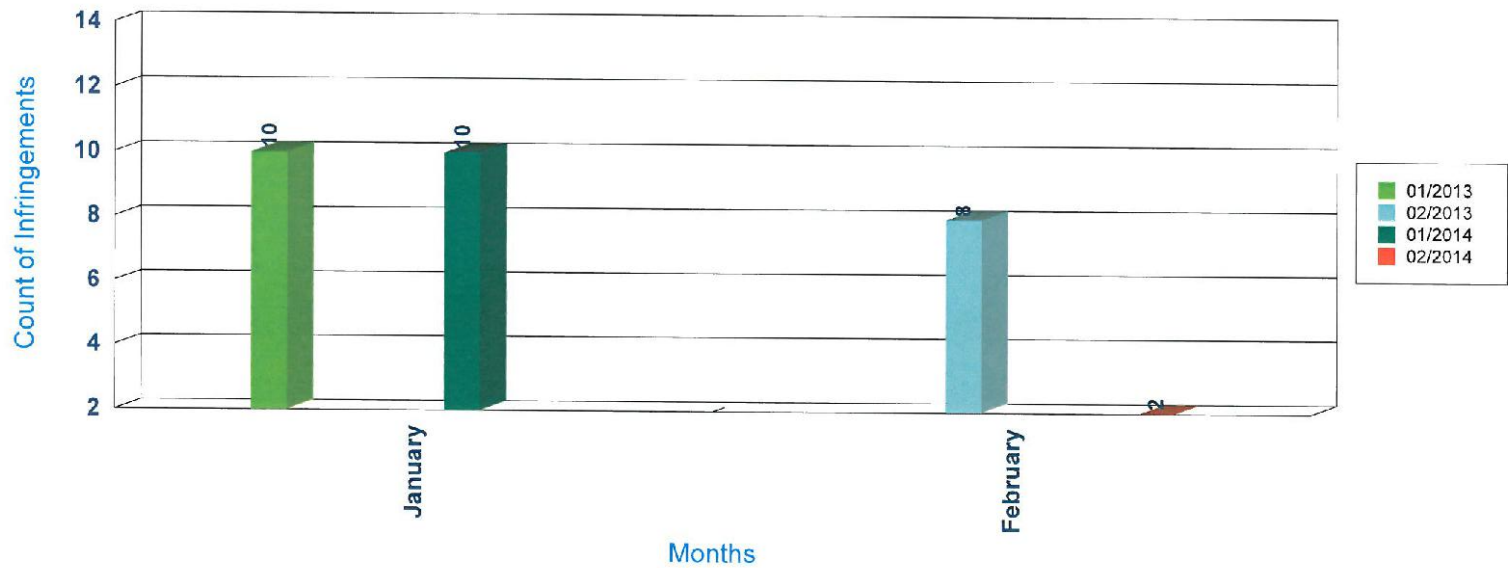

Local Law Infringements Comparison Year to Date January 2014

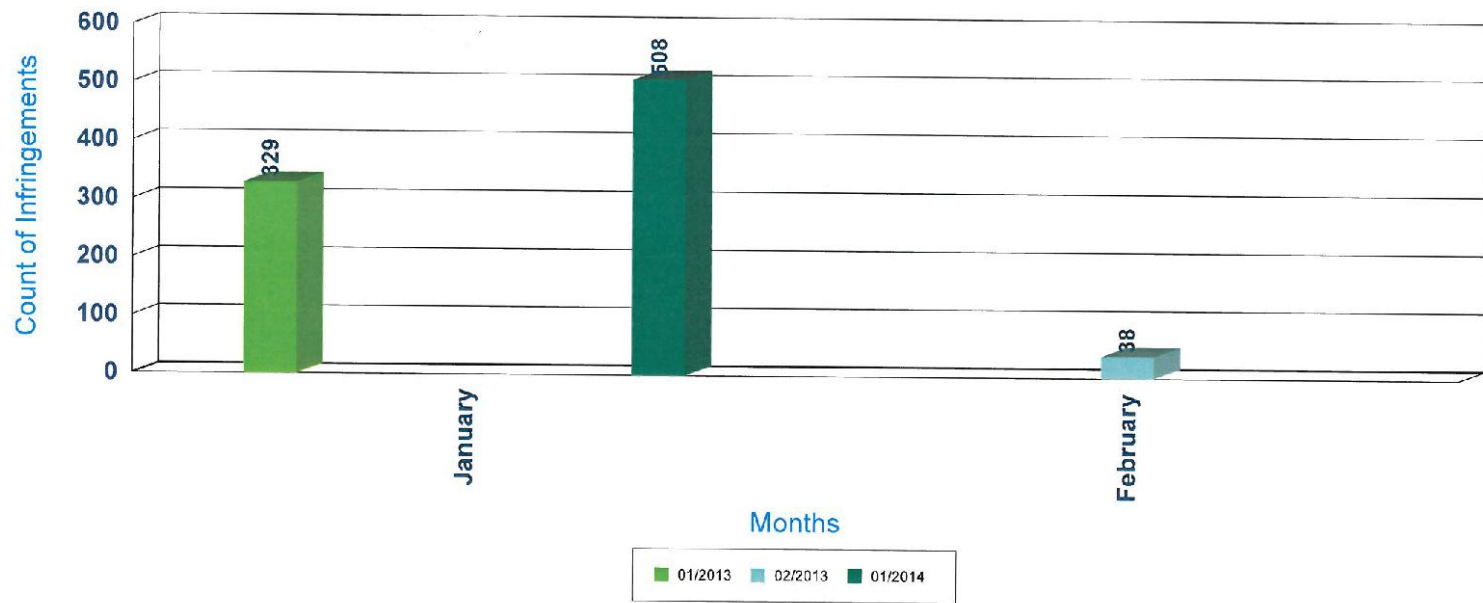
