SUMMARY

The report seeks a direction from the Committee as to what issues the Council may wish to raise with the State Government at the Community Cabinet to be conducted in Rockhampton on 24 May 2015.

OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

THAT relevant information be prepared on the issues identified at this meeting for raising during the forthcoming Community Cabinet to be held in Rockhampton 24/25 May 2015.

COMMENTARY

Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk last week announced that Rockhampton would play host to her Government's second Community Cabinet on 24 and 25 May. Community Cabinet gives the Council the opportunity to speak directly with Ministers and Directors-General about issues affecting the region and reconstruction following TC Marcia.

The Rockhampton and Yeppoon Community Cabinet will be held on Sunday 24 and Monday 25 May at North Rockhampton State High School. A public forum will be held from 1pm, Sunday 24 May, with formal deputations to take place from 2pm to 4.30pm.

Council at various times over the past few years have identified a number of projects considered to be priority projects including matters raised at the Community Cabinet held in the Keppel electorate by the previous State Government. It is considered that any issues raised should come from the previously agreed priority projects and those were:

- Fitzroy Agricultural Corridor and Lower Fitzroy Infrastructure Project;
- Mount Morgan Water Supply;
- Flood Mitigation Stage 2 of NRFMP;
- Riverfront Revitalisation Project; and
- Military Precinct at Airport.

It is suggested that others that could be raised are:

- Pilbeam Drive (part will be Category B under NDRRA);
- Maintenance of creeks and waterways by State Government;
- Support for gauging and warning stations in creeks;
- Rockhampton Ring Road and Third Bridge; and
- Military presence in the Region.

Committee direction is sought on what issues should be raised.
