C/22/00834	20/11/22		It was alleged a councillor breached the code of conduct by not responding to a request to meet with a resident over operational issues.	28/11/22	Dismissed	<p>The OIA dismissed this matter pursuant to section 150X(a)(ii) of the Local Government Act 2009 [the Act] as the conduct does not raise a reasonable suspicion of inappropriate conduct or misconduct within the meaning of the Act.</p> <p>The councillor did respond and stated the request would be passed onto council who were the appropriate entity to deal with the issue as it was operational.</p> <p>Enquiries confirmed the councillor had appropriately passed on the request.</p>		OIA
