Conditions of Entry

The Promoter is Rockhampton Regional Council.

Eligibility Requirements

- Entrant must reside at a residentially zoned property within Rockhampton Regional Council's declared kerbside collection service area, that receives a rated general waste and recycling wheelie bin service.
- Entries will be cross referenced with results from Council's Residential Recycling Program – Bin Health Check.
- Entrants that have received a healthy bin tag as part of the Bin Health Check for the general waste and recycling wheelie bin service at their residential address will be eligible to win the monthly prize.

Permissions

- Entering the Competition is evidence of the Entrant's consent to these Conditions of Entry.
- No more than one entry per person is allowed. If more than one entry is received for a single person, then additional entries will be invalid and only one entry will remain in the prize draw.
- Council employees, Councillors and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter the Competition.
- Personal information collected by Rockhampton Regional Council by entering the Competition is not passed on to third parties.
- Council deals with personal information in accordance with law, including the *Information Privacy Act 2009*.
- By providing contact information on entries, it will be deemed as the Entrants' consent to their name, phone, address, and email being available to Rockhampton Regional Council to use to contact the winners and arrange a photo of the recipient with the prize.
