HOW TO OPT-IN:



- 1 VISIT THE DASHBOARD SITE**
Go to Council's Disaster Dashboard at <https://emergency.rockhamptonregion.qld.gov.au> and select "Opt-In for Emergency Dashboard Alerts".

- 2 REGISTER YOUR DETAILS**
Ensure you're on the "Register" tab and complete the required information. Click the "Sign up" button when finished to submit the form.




3 VERIFY YOUR PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS

Verify your phone number by entering the code that has been sent to your phone and select “Verify” An email will also be sent to you, click the link in the email to verify your email address.



4 LOGIN TO SET YOUR NOTIFICATION PREFERENCES

Once you have verified your email address and phone number, return to the dashboard homepage and select the “Opt-In for Emergency Dashboard Alerts” button again and sign-in.

6 SELECT YOUR LOCATION/S

To successfully receive alerts, you'll need to make sure you select the relevant locations/type of warnings that you'd like to receive alerts for. For Weather Warnings, click on the blue 'Select Locations' link and select your desired region/s (Rockhampton, Capricornia, Fitzroy River) and disaster type/s. You can select as many as you like. Click 'Save' in the pop-up box to confirm your selection.

For Bushfire Warnings, click 'Select Locations' and choose the suburb/s that you'd like to receive bushfire warnings for.

Select 'Save Changes' underneath the table to confirm and save all of your selections.
