#### SUMMARY

The Queensland Department of Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning have released a funding pool (Works for Queensland Program) to be allocated to Councils outside the south-east corner of Queensland. Rockhampton's allocation is \$9,380,000. This report considers projects to be allocated to this fund. Applications close on 24 February 2017.

#### OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

THAT the following projects be submitted under the State Government's Works for Queensland Program:

- Rockhampton Hockey Relocation (\$2,475,375)
- 42ND Battalion Pool Water Play (\$1,230,000)
- Cedric Archer Park Water Play (\$1,537,500)
- New North Rockhampton Boat Ramp Carpark and Walkways (\$1,500,000)
- Mount Morgan Streetscaping (\$1,060,686)
- Facility Upgrades (\$1,576,439)

#### **COMMENTARY**

The Works for Queensland Program from which Rockhampton Regional Council has been allocated \$9.38m requires projects to be submitted in the prescribed format by 24 February. The other requirements are that these projects must be completed by 30 November and must not be in the current year's budget.

Attached is a list of projects that is recommended to be submitted as part of this program.

- Rockhampton Hockey Relocation \$2,475,375
- 42ND Battalion (Northside) Pool Water Play \$1,230,000
- Cedric Archer Park Water Play \$1,537,500
- New North Rockhampton Boat Ramp Carpark and Walkways \$1,500,000
- Mount Morgan Streetscaping \$1,060,686
- Facility Upgrades \$1,576,439

Council will be aware of the content of these projects and further elaboration can take place at the meeting. The facility upgrades is in reality the balancing item as these come from an extensive list totalling over \$3m.

#### CONCLUSION

It is recommended that these projects be submitted for consideration under the Works for Queensland Program.
