

IMMUNISATION PROCEDURE

1 Scope:

This procedure applies to Rockhampton Regional Council employees, volunteers and contractors identified as being at risk due to potential hazards in their relevant work environments. This procedure does not supersede advice provided by a registered health professional.

2 Purpose:

To provide a process outlining:

- The obligations of employees and W&S; and
- Risk control options to avoid possible infection of a vaccine preventable disease.

4 Definitions:

To assist in interpretation, the following definitions apply:

At Risk	Regular exposure to biological hazards, particularly where				
	there is a potential for contact with bodily substances.				
Contractor	A person or organisation who performs a specific act or acts including the provision of services and/or materials to another person or organisation under an agreement enforceable by law.				
Council	Rockhampton Regional Council				
Employee	Local government employee: (a) the chief executive officer; or (b) a person holding an appointment under section 196 of the Local Government Act 2009.				

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Immunity to a Disease	Having a protective level of resistance to a particular infectious disease.		
New Employees	A person who is appointed as an employee to a position within Council, including existing employees who have applied and/or been appointed to another position.		
Non Responder	A person who has been vaccinated against an infectious disease, but who has documented evidence that they have not developed a protective level of resistance to the disease.

5 Procedure:

5.1 Independent Review

A review of Council positions was undertaken by an independent registered health professional and those positions where immunisation was recommended were identified. Identified positions with recommended immunisations are listed in Appendix 1 and 2.

5.2 New Employees

- **5.2.1** As detailed in the Immunisation Policy, required immunisations for new employees are listed as a condition of employment.
- **5.2.2** Within one month of the new employee's commencement date the new employee must provide (to W&S) evidence from a registered health professional that they have commenced the required immunisation program.

5.3 Restricted Tasks

- 5.3.1 The implementation of work restrictions may be required for employees who have no immunity to vaccine preventable diseases, who perform at risk activities, work in at risk environments or have contact with persons infected with a vaccine preventable disease.
- **5.3.2** Some immunisations require a period of time before immunity is obtained. In areas of moderate or high risk, an employee's tasks should be restricted until this period has lapsed. A risk assessment must be conducted to identify controls to implement safe work practices, requirements for additional training and the provision of PPE to employees.

5.4 Management of a Vaccine Preventable Disease Outbreak

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- 5.4.1 In the event of a vaccine preventable disease outbreak within the workplace, it may be necessary to exclude non-immune employees from the workplace or to implement work restrictions to protect the non-immune employees and to prevent further spread of the disease.
- **5.4.2** W&S should seek advice from an expert source, such as Queensland Health, for how to appropriately manage the outbreak.

5.5 First Aid Officers

- **5.5.1** Employees appointed as an Appointed First Aid Officer are issued with an appointment letter outlining their immunisation responsibilities. The letter is to be completed, signed and submitted to W&S for placement on the employee's personnel file.
- **5.5.2** Existing Appointed First Aid Officers must comply with immunisation responsibilities. Appointed First Aid Officers who refuse to comply with their immunisation responsibilities may forfeit the Appointed First Aid Officer role.

5.6 Volunteers

- **5.6.1** Volunteers operating in an at risk work environment are provided with the necessary information, instruction, training and supervision of risks of vaccine preventable diseases and safe work practices to be implemented to prevent spreading contagious diseases within the workplace.
- **5.6.2** Council should review safe work practices and, if necessary, implement further controls to minimise the risk of vaccine preventable diseases to volunteers. Controls may include additional training and the provision of PPE to volunteers.
- 5.6.3 Non-immune volunteers are restricted to work in low at risk environments. The relevant department should review work practices and if necessary implement work restrictions and provide PPE where appropriate.

5.7 Contractors

Contractors are responsible for ensuring their employees, agents and representatives are appropriately immunised for vaccine preventable diseases. Contractors may be requested to provide evidence of immunisation records at any time during the term of the agreement. Contract documentation for work involving activities that put contractors at risk must specify relevant control measures to be implemented to reduce the risk of exposure to vaccine preventable diseases.

5.8 Reimbursement of Immunisation Costs

- **5.8.1** As detailed in the Immunisation Policy, some immunisation costs are absorbed by Council. In these instances the employee is to provide a copy of the paid invoice to their relevant department personal assistant for reimbursement (following reimbursement from Medicare or other health fund if applicable). The personal assistant is to then forward a copy of the invoice to W&S for recording and filing.
- **5.8.2** Costs are absorbed by the relevant department.

5.9 Recordkeeping

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Copies of employee immunisation documents are kept on the employee's personal file and remains confidential. Records include:

- Records or statements from a registered health professional;
- Completed Immunisation Refusal and Acknowledgement of Risk Forms; and
- Associated blood tests and other relevant test results.

Employees should maintain their own records of immunisations.

5.9.1 Register of Immunisations

W&S maintains a confidential register of employee immunisations that:

- Records immunisation records received;
- Identifies employees who are not immunised;
- Details costs absorbed by Council;
- Monitors employee immunisation compliance;
- Lists dates of required immunisation boosters;
- Details required vaccinations and timeframes; and
- Notes received Immunisation Refusal and Acknowledgement of Risk Forms.

5.10 Immunisation Refusal

Employees identified as requiring immunisations that refuse immunisation, are unable to be immunised for medical reasons or does not respond to immunisation must provide details of their refusal and take responsibility for their decision by completing the Immunisation Refusal and Acknowledgement of Risk Form. The completed form is to be submitted to W&S for placement on the employee's personnel file.

Immunisation refusal should be limited as it is listed as a position requirement for at risk employees.

5.10.1 Immunisation Refusal without Reason

Employees that refuse immunisation without reason will be dealt with in accordance with the Discipline Procedure.

5.11 Encouragement of Employees to be Immunised

Supervisors/managers are to encourage employees to be immunised. Information about the relevant vaccine-preventable diseases and the benefits of immunisation should be provided to employees.

5.12 Risk Assessments

- **5.12.1** A risk assessment to determine the most appropriate method of protecting against vaccine-preventable diseases must be conducted by the employee and their supervisor for the following scenarios:
 - Employees who refuse immunisation;
 - Employees unable to be vaccinated for medical reasons; and
 - Employees who do not respond to immunisation.

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Section 7 of the Immunisation Refusal and Acknowledgement of Risk Form is to be used to conduct the risk assessment.

- **5.12.2** The risk assessment should give consideration to the way in which the relevant vaccine preventable disease is spread.
- **5.12.3** Control measures must be implemented to ensure vaccine preventable disease exposure to at risk employees is minimised. Measures may include:
 - Ensuring appropriate work placement and adjustment;
 - Implementing work restrictions;
 - Reviewing work practices to ensure safe procedures are in use;
 - Providing additional information, instruction, training and supervision;
 - Providing PPE; and
 - Applying outbreak management measures (for example: work restrictions and exclusion to protect the employee and to prevent further outbreak).
- **5.12.3** The employee's manager should review the completed risk assessment to ensure the most appropriate methods of protecting the employee against infection have been identified.
- **5.12.5** Appropriate ways to protect non-immune employees may include a combination of preventative measures, outbreak management measures and post-exposure protocols.

5.13 Exposure to a Vaccine Preventable Disease

If a non-immune employee becomes exposed to a vaccine-preventable disease, medical treatment must be sought as soon as possible. In some instances a post-exposure prophylaxis can be administered.

An employee who suffers a skin penetrating injury must follow the Safeplan Skin Penetrating Injuries - Infection Control Procedure.

5.13.1 Work-caused Infections

Work-caused infection of a vaccine preventable disease requires notification to WHSQ as a prescribed serious illness. These notifications are to be made by the Safety Supervisor or delegate.

6 Review Timelines:

This procedure will be reviewed when any of the following occur:

- **6.1** The related information is amended or replaced; or
- **6.2** Other circumstances as determined from time to time by the General Manager.
