#### **WE CARE**

- # Children under 12 should stay in the vehicle at all times because there are lots of hazards on the site for little ones, and in the car is the safest place to be.
- Closed in shoes should be worn on site to prevent injury if standing on sharp or contaminated objects and to protect toes from dropped or falling objects.
- Speed limits are set in place on site to ensure safety of pedestrians and drivers onsite are able to move about the shared areas and use the facility safely.
