SUMMARY

The following report provides an overview of key capital works and maintenance activities within Civil Operations.

BACKGROUND

An update on current Civil Operations is provided in this report.

Maintenance

For the 2022/2023 financial year, Council has committed \$12,313,352 towards maintenance to the civil asset networks.

To date, these works have generally been progressing in line with the available budget with limited variation.

A summary of both roads recently graded and those scheduled to be graded in the coming month is provided below:
