

General Site Safety Rules Glenmore Water Treatment Plant

- **1.** All vehicles on site shall adhere to the speed limit of 15km/hr throughout the site.
- 2. All vehicles shall be parked in designated parking bay unless the vehicle is loading in a loading bay or behind a suitable barricade elsewhere.
- 3. Visitors shall not drive beyond the visitor's car park located at the administration building.
- **4.** All visitors shall report to reception to sign in and collect a visitor's tag that must be worn at all times. Escorted tours are exempt.
- **5.** Escorted tour group members are to remain with the Rockhampton Regional Council guide for the duration of the tour.
- **6.** All minors are to be prevented from climbing on or over railings or other barricades by the visiting guardians.
- **7.** All visitors are to keep clear of machinery and chemical storage vessels and must refrain from touching levers and switches.
- **8.** All accidents/incidents and/or hazards must be reported immediately to a supervisor or member of site management.
- **9.** Firearms and drugs are prohibited within the grounds of the Glenmore Water Treatment Plant (GWTP) and vehicles.
- **10.** Smoking is forbidden within all of the GWTP site buildings and vehicles.
- **11.** Cameras are only allowed on site with the authorisation of the Manager Fitzroy River Water.
- **12.** Bullying and/or harassing behaviour is not acceptable on or in the GWTP site and vehicles.
- **13.** Personal protective equipment shall be worn as indicated by the signs across the site.

IN THE EVENT OF EVACUATION:

- **1.** Follow all instructions given by Wardens or Fire Officers.
- **2.** Move quickly, do not run.
- **3.** If possible, close doors behind you.
- **4.** Assist persons with Special Needs (eg mobility impaired, children)
- **5.** Visitors will be accounted for as per the sign-in register.
- **6.** Report to the designated assembly area; main gate into GWTP.
- **7.** If any injuries are sustained, notify a Warden.
- **8.** Advise Warden immediately if you are aware of people trapped in a building.
- **9.** Do not leave the assembly area until the Chief Warden gives the "All- clear".
