present day...

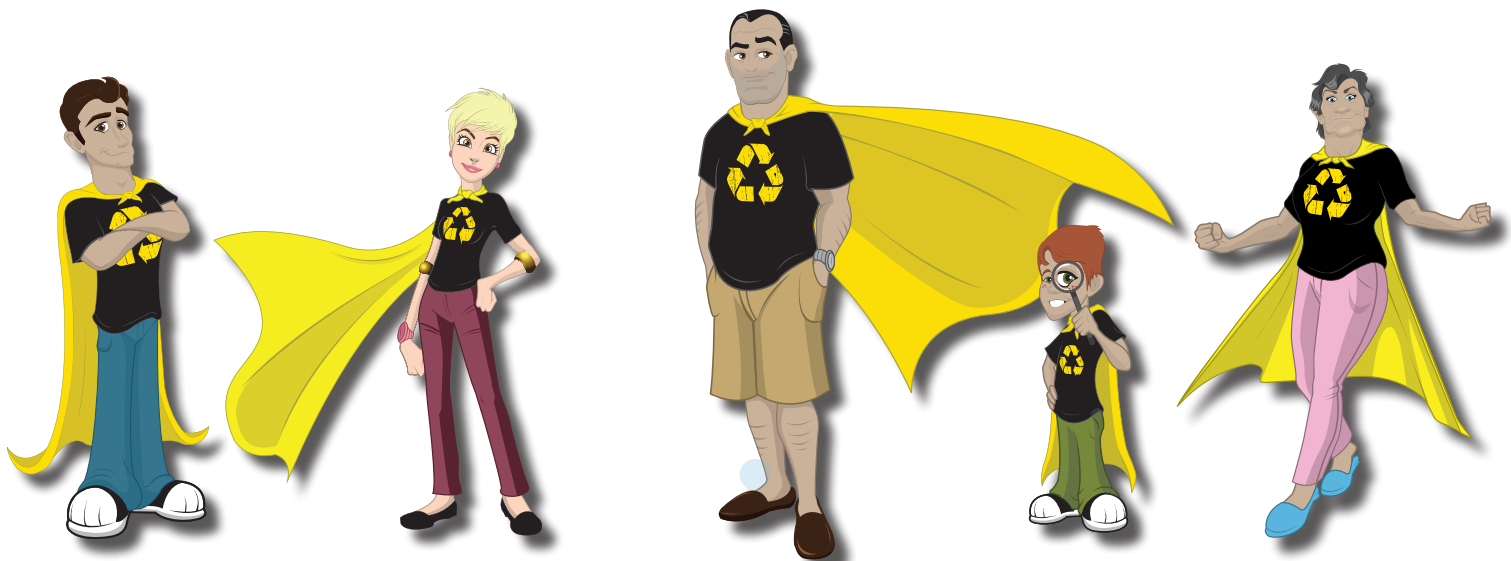

Using grease, plastic bags or food scraps, and putting the wrong items in yellow lid bins, this evil monster is trying to contaminate clean recyclable items.
