FROM THE DIRECTOR

George Orwell's 1984 is the ultimate horror story of a state's power over the individual. Written just after World War II, as a warning about the dangers of totalitarianism, this magnificent novel has never lost its relevance, and has proved to be chillingly prophetic. When we first staged this production in 2012, audiences recognised immediately the parallels with our own world: the "Doublespeak" of political leaders, their use of propaganda and "spin" to hide the truth, surveillance and the threat to privacy through our electronic devices, the use of government subterfuge to justify war etc. There were comments like: "I was reminded of North Korea today" and "it was a good reminder to appreciate the pleasures and privileges of a liberal society and to take note of what we have to lose". The possibility of Orwell's world coming true in our lifetime was an awful prospect to entertain, certainly, but...it was an unlikely one - a kind of imaginative "what if". After all, our systems of government would never allow this to happen. We are democratic. We have checks and balances. We have common values related to freedom and the rights of humanity. We are the West.

Fast-forward thirteen years. A lot has changed. Is the notion of complete control of society by the state and three autocratic superpowers ruling the world still just a dystopian fantasy from an old novel? Can we in the West still confidently take our freedom for granted? And perhaps most importantly, are we able to distinguish between what is true and what is not?

We once again have the opportunity and privilege to tour 1984 around Australia. Over the last few weeks this wonderful Shake & Stir team has worked with imagination and passion to bring the strange world of Winston Smith to life. We have embraced digital technology to enhance the exploration of the narrative, which creates exciting options for us to delve into the labyrinths of Winston's mind. I hope the production will inspire many a discussion amongst our audiences about the enormous and compelling questions this profound story raises: what is freedom? What is truth? Does two plus two really equal four?
